Causes of poverty:

- 1 Natural disasters; wildfires, floods, climate change,
- 2 World systems: Social injustice; Political systems; economic imbalances,
- 3 Disability and illnesses,
- 4 Selfishness and evil practices,
- 5 Spiritual poverty

Effects of Poverty:

- 1 Condemnation and marginalization,
- 2 Associated with weakness and shame,
- 3 Stigmatization and isolation

Cure for poverty: Jesus is offering blessings instead of condemnation. Jesus identifies with the poor and empathised with them. Jesus promises the poor joy and happiness in the Kingdom of God where both the rich and the poor will be all equal before the throne of God.

Jesus invites us, the church, to participate in His missional work of serving the poor in our communities. We need to examine ourselves regarding personal attitudes towards wealth and poverty. Blessed is the hand that gives. **Amen.**
